
PFS WANTS: Prayers for our continued good works helping families in crisis.

HERE ARE SOME CHANGES -- WE ARE GROWING

- PFS spent many months partnering with Catholic Charities in the disbursement of COVID funds after vetting clients for the Mahoning County Commissioners office.
- PFS began working with a social worker and her 12 homebound families with disabled children around Thanksgiving continue to help though Christmas and now.
- On Christmas Eve our director joined an amazing group at noon to deliver dinner and gifts to families at Motel 30. They sang Christmas songs and prayed together.
- Now that we are part of the YNDC family so many new doors for PFS. I was able to network with the mayor at the ribbon cutting for our neighbor Glenwood Fresh Food Market on 4-12-22. I also met a representative from Akron Children's Hospital and will be working with them and their food program. Our neighbor across the street, Glenwood Grounds coffee, pasty & sandwich shop was also there to network with.
- PFS has enhanced our Senior Stability Program and will reimplement our MORE MONEY THAN MONTH budget class.
